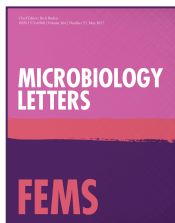
## *Human Pathogens in the Environment*

Many of the most serious human infectious agents are either derived from the wider environment or have environmental reservoirs. In this issue, we aim to explore the underlying biology, transmission cycles and risk factors for a wide breadth of microbes, from the well-known food-borne pathogens, to those that are less well characterized and described, covering bacteria, fungi/fungal-like pathogens and protozoa. Submissions are invited in the form of original research, MiniReviews, reviews, opinion pieces and perspectives.
